Alan Werk

Lives: near Verndale, Minnesota

Farm Operation: beef cow-calf operation, raises corn, oats and hay.

Injury: Alan lost both arms and part of one leg in a corn picker.

Barrier: Alan uses two prosthetic arms and one prosthetic leg. He has difficulty carrying large or heavy objects, holding tools, operating small switches/controls and walking distances over rough terrain.

Alan uses this gator to move equipment and feed around the farmyard.





Prosthetic limbs with metal pincers that work like fingers help Alan do the work that he did before the accident.

Alan modified these tools with extra rings to grip with his hooks or with terminal ends that mount directly into his prosthetic arm.
